We are the volunteers who have been working very hard for the last year to humanely reduce the cat overpopulation in this neighbourhood. We've been feeding these cats every day, spaying and neutering them, and caring for those who are sick, injured and pregnant.

You may be shocked to know there are well over 200 cats living here. We have spayed and neutered 172 of them, and have placed 64 kittens and 11 adults into loving homes. We have had to do a LOT of fundraising to raise most of the \$20,646 it has cost to help and feed this many cats for a year. We're happy to do it, because these guys really need the help. So...

We're REALLY hoping you will help us out by driving a little more carefully on this street.

Look out for cats and PLEASE try not to run over them. We love these cats, and when we have to scrape one off the road it results in very loud weeping and a lot of kleenex. We lost two of our boys in the last four days. Their names were Terek and Trigg. They mattered to us, and we did our best to make sure they had the best lives they possibly could.

Please help us save us money on therapy bills and kleenex by helping keep our cats safe.
